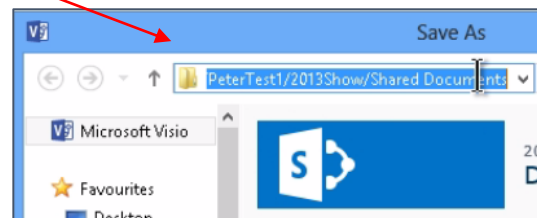
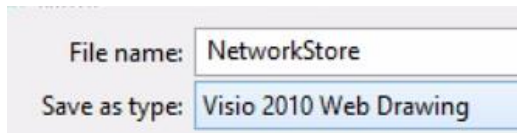
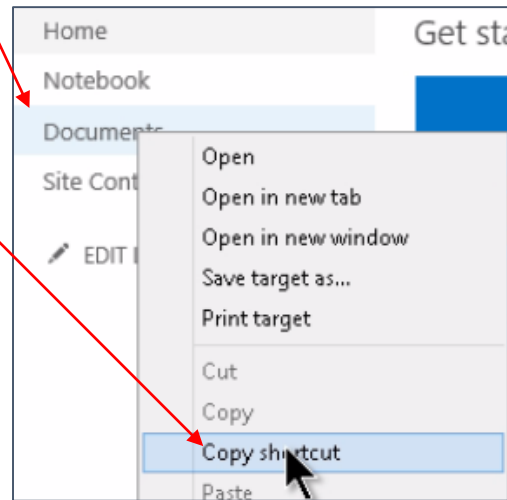


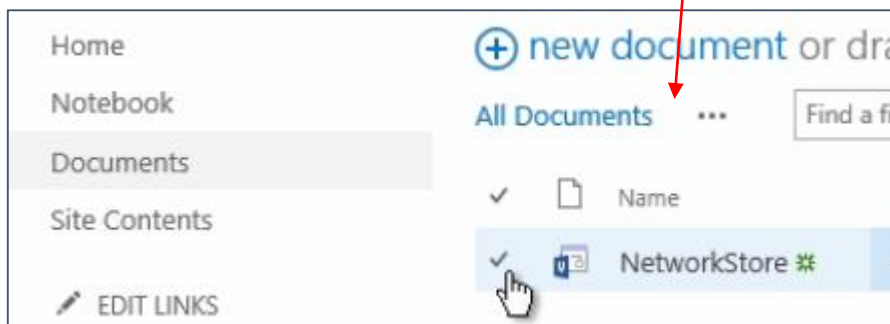
Insert a Visio 2010 Web drawing into a Visio Web Access Web Part (only for the Enterprise version of SharePoint 2013)

● Step 1, open a NetworkStore.vsd file and save it to SharePoint as a Visio 2010 Web drawing

- 1) In the **SharePoint site**, right click on "Documents"
- 2) Click on the "Copy shortcut"
- 3) Go to the **Visio**
- 4) **Open** the file **NetworkStore.vsd**
- 5) Select the "File" tab
- 6) Click Save as
- 7) Click on the "Browse" button
- 8) Paste the **URL**
- 9) Remove the part "**Forms/AllItems.aspx**" from the URL
- 10) Save as type **Visio 2010 Web Drawing**

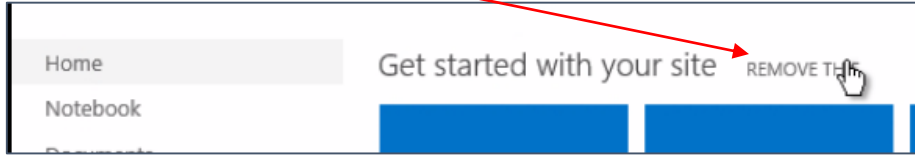


- 11) Click Save
- 12) Check that the file is uploaded in the SharePoint site **Document library**

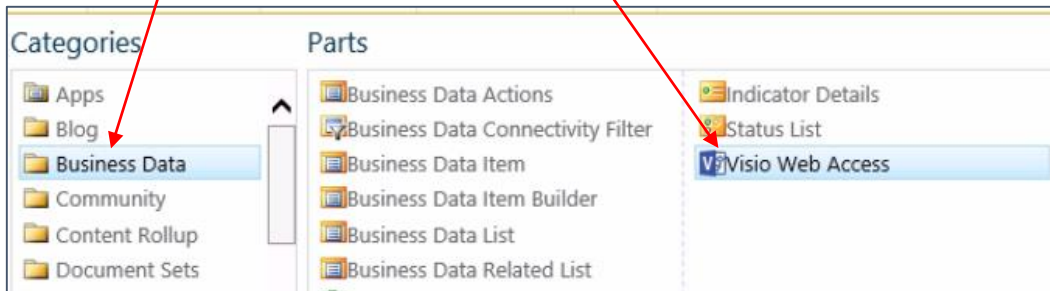
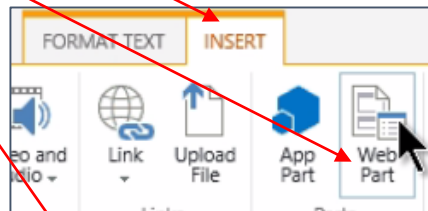
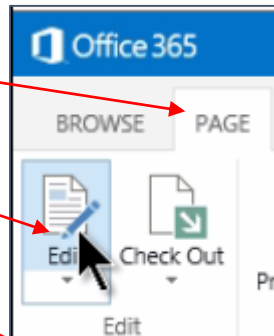


● **Step 2, add a Visio Web Access Web Part to the Home page**

- 1) Go to the **SharePoint** site Home page
- 2) Click "Remove this"

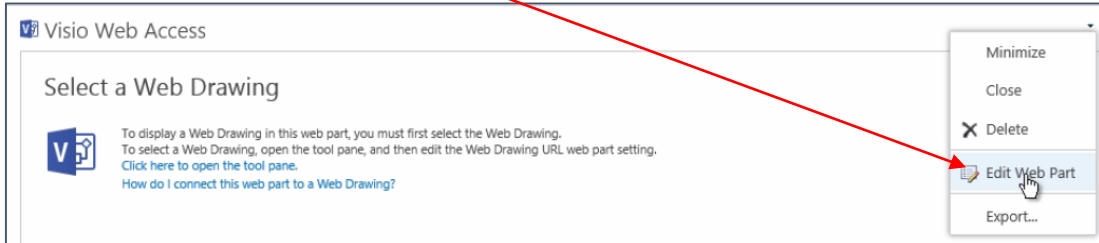


- 3) Select the "Page" tab at the top

- 6) Select "Web Part"
- 7) Select "Business Data"
- 8) Select "Visio Web Access"
- 9) Click Add

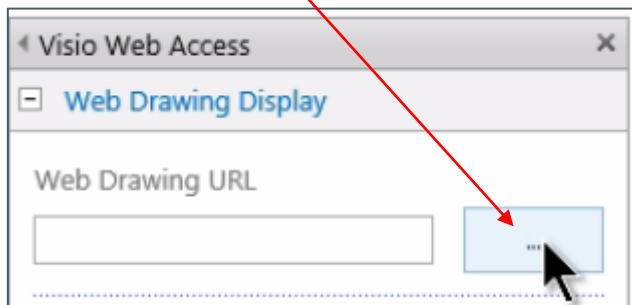


● **Step 3, connect the Web Part to the NetworkStore Web drawing file**

- 2) Select the "Edit Web Part"



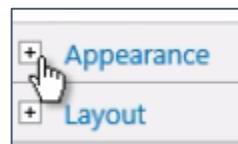
- 3) Click on the "Browse" button to pick up the Web Drawing URL



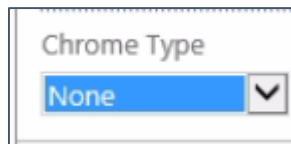
- 4) Browse to the Documents library and select the file NetworkStore.vdw"
